


HOW THE FLINT HILLS REGIONAL LEADERSHIP PROGRAM MAKES A DIFFERENCE

Through a seven-session intensive training experience the Flint Hills Regional Leadership Program (FHRLP) provides wisdom building opportunities for our emerging regional leaders. Our graduates can be a key voice of reason affecting positive change in an ever-changing world. The annual program develops the leadership skills necessary to help the Flint Hills Region become the best place in Kansas to live, work & raise families. Our future depends on solid leadership that has a broad-based understanding of needs and resource management to meet those needs. The Flint Hills Regional Leadership Program takes participants working or living within the mapped area through a series of sessions that enhances team building, mediation, and collaboration skills, builds communication and image presentation ability and community decision making skills.

Case study exposure to successful businesses develops economic literacy and governmental analysis sharpens awareness of the process of local and state law and regulation development. The participants also gain skills in the art of informed influence. Conflict management, risk assessment and intervention provide direct exposure to making a difference at the local community through our statewide, national, and global concerns. Trend analysis aids in the ability to create a vision for the future.
